

If you own a car, you should know this: It's the Law

Using Autolite or other quality brand name spark plugs does not void vehicle warranty.

Some automobile dealer service representatives falsely claim brand name spark plugs “void the vehicle warranty” if used instead of the original equipment brand spark plugs during the warranty period.

That claim is not true. Under the Magnuson-Moss Warranty Improvement Act, a vehicle manufacturer may **not** make its vehicle warranty conditional on the use of any brand of spark plug (or other article or service) **unless** the manufacturer provides

the spark plugs (or other article or service) free of charge or the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) has specifically published that only the vehicle manufacturer's product is needed. To challenge a false claim, ask the person to put it in writing or request the original equipment spark plugs **free of charge**. If you are charged for the spark plugs, or they refuse to give you a written statement, there may be a violation of Federal law.
